Yener Görsev

Dr. Görsev Yener works as a professor of Neurology in Izmir Biomedicine and Genome Center, at Dokuz Eylül University Campus in Izmir, Turkey. She is one of the founders of an outpatient dementia clinic in her university after returning from a behavioral neurology fellowship at UCLA, the USA in 1993. Dokuz Eylül University's dementia clinic is one of the first dementia clinics in Turkey. In 2010, Dokuz Eylül University Brain Dynamics Multidisciplinary Center that she chairs since 2006,



was awarded being a dementia excellence center of European Alzheimer's Disease Consortium (EADC). She became also the founding chairperson of the Neuroscience Department in Health Sciences Institute in 2004 and is continuing to teach in the same department since then. A student of hers from the university's postgraduate neuroscience program became the first associate professor of neuroscience in Turkey in 2017. She was one of the founders' Executive Committee Members in the Turkish Alzheimer's Association, and later became the founder of the first branch in Izmir, in which she is still an active member.
